FE FIGHTS BACK

The pay crisis in further education isn't a game. So what are the Association of Colleges playing at?

In an inflammatory and deeply unhelpful move, the Association of Colleges (AoC) have refused to consider a national pay discussion this year, unless UCU resolve every dispute with local colleges beforehand. It's worse than insulting - it's a disgrace.

IT'S A MATTER OF SURVIVAL

The FE sector desperately needs to address many years of underfunding and overpromising. Spending on our colleges has stagnated and the problems with recruitment and retention have reached damaging levels.

We need the AoC to be responsible and pay staff some respect, not play for time. Staff have waited long enough already - the pay crisis is too serious to ignore.

UCU SAYS FE MUST FIGHT BACK

Join the fight for 5% or £1500.

The joint trade unions in FE are claiming a pay increase of 5% or £1500 (whichever is greater) for 2018/19.

In colleges where there is not sufficient progress to address these issues, members will be balloted for industrial action over the summer.
